1. Age groups (Age calculated as on 1st January 2020)

Infant Category

As agreed in 2017 Teachers Conference, Sub Juniors age category is now split into two; Infants and Subjuniors. Age 4 to 7 students will come under Sub junior category and can participate in this event. Elocution topics will be common for both categories.

Note: Head teachers to <u>carefully</u> place students in their respective age groups based on their <u>age</u> and this should be strictly adhered.

2. <u>Common Rules</u>

Δ Participants should ensure word clarity in all the events.

 Δ All participants should ensure direct eye contact with the camera, whilst recording.

Δ All parents have to complete online registration forms at unit levels, thereby consenting for video recording & publishing on public platforms.

 Δ All participants registered by 09th Aug 2020, will only be considered for the event.

ΔIndividual unit head teachers are responsible for conducting ZOOM recordings at unit levels and submitting it to the responsible District Coordinators, before 15th September 2020.

BIBLE QUIZ EVENT GUIDELINES

Quiz event is aimed at improving Sunday school children's knowledge on biblical, church history, faith and tradition aspects. In 2020, we aim to conduct quiz event, via Zoom, based on the guidelines given below with a view to promote children's general knowledge anchored on Sunday school education.

This quiz event to be held for Intermediates & Seniors combined.

Guidelines on Topics

- 1. Quiz event questions to be prepared at Diocese level based on the following topic:
- Round 1: Joshua 25 %
- Round 2: St Mark 5%
- Round 3: Holy Baptism & Holy Qurbana 25%
- Round 4: Church history & Tradition 25%
- The decision of the quizmaster will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
- Honest participation is expected, given the current situation, as this event is being held online. The
 participants shall not be allowed to use any books, manuscripts, mobile phones or other electronic
 instruments. Date and time for the Quiz even will announced in the Due course.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

<u>Unit Level</u>

Due to the current pandemic situation the OSSAE UK, Europe, Africa and Ireland 2020 talent event has been adapted to an online event. We are hoping this will be give all students a chance to participate equally.

THE PLAN FOR THIS EVENT IS TO CONDUCT IT USING ZOOM RECORDINGS AT UNIT LEVELS.

- 1) All candidates are to register online via Google Documents, ensuring parental consent for video recordings and submissions for judging.
- 2) Sunday school units should conduct talent event to a date which suit the unit's convenience, but it should be conducted in consultation with vicar and teachers council.
- Unit level talent event should be conducted and submitted by 15th September 2020. Head teachers are to submit recordings to their respective District coordinators.

Note:

→If there seems to be a problem with the network (due to broadband/bandwidth issues), the head teacher may ask the candidate to repeat the performance.

 \rightarrow This year all participating students will be appreciated through a digital certificate, a memento of appreciation. As done in the previous years, their participation will be reflected in their internal assessment.

OSSAE-UK & I: Circular on Talent Event 2020

GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES

- The talent event should be conducted impartially and organizers must adhere to the competition rules and guidelines given in this Circular.
- 2. Individual unit head teachers to ensure all participants have registered by the 09th August.
- 3. The talent event should be organized and supervised by the Head Teacher<u>only</u> in consultation with teacher's council headed by the parish Vicar. In case of any inconvenience <u>only</u> his/her deputy or a senior teacher of the respective Sunday school should be authorized to conduct the event. Head teachers should give enough notice to the candidates, for them to prepare well in advance for the online talent event.

All head teachers, must ensure video recordings are saved & submitted to their respective District coordinators by 15th September 2020, using the below format.

- 5. All District coordinators must ensure recordings are submitted by 30th September 2020, to Talent Competition Coordinators
- 6. All communications from OSSAE-UK & Ireland Office will be made to the head teacher only.
- 7. The rules for the event, topics for the elocution, and number of participants will be as per this circular (Please refer to Appendix II). It will be the participant's responsibility to learn to manage time.
- 8. Sunday school units may continue to organize suitable Co-Curricular activities which include arts & sports and other events, such as Bible quiz, Bible reading, essay, and story writing, drawing and coloring for promoting various talents of our students.
