Infant Category

As agreed in 2017 Teachers Conference, Sub Juniors age category is now split into two; Infants and Sub-juniors. Age 4 students will be grouped under Infant category and can only participate in unit level competitions. Age 5 to 7 students will come under Sub junior category and can participate in further levels of competition. Elocution topics will be common for both categories.

Note: Head teachers to <u>carefully</u> place students in their respective age groups based on their <u>age</u> and this should be strictly adhered.

2. <u>Common Rules</u>

- > Written manuscripts, electronic, visual aids/devices of any kind will not be permitted.
- Prompting (action, guidance) will not be permitted.
- > Participants should ensure word clarity in all the events.
- Participant should ensure direct eye contact with camera, whilst recording to ensure no visual aids are used.
- All parents have to complete online registration form at unit levels, thereby giving consent for video recording.

EVENTS FOR CENTRALIZED EVENT 2022

SOLO SONG

This year, the OSSAE UK Talent Event 2022 team has decided to initiate Essay writing for intermediate and senior category. This will be conducted for both categories on the same day at Unit level only. Head teachers should ensure essay writing is conducted **on a date which suits the unit's convenience**, but it should be conducted in consultation with vicar and teacher's council, and by ensuring the presence of Vicar or a Priest authorised by the vicar at the venue of the event. Paper will be provided by church and mobile and electronic devices won't be allowed.

• Intermediate

Topic: How to spiritually nurture ourselves and be connected with the church during this pandemic period?

Marking criteria- Content should include:

→ Personal, Family and Church experiences

 \rightarrow Produce positive suggestions for spiritual growth.

 \rightarrow 500-750 words

• Seniors

Topic: 1Peter 3:9 "Not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead" Marking Criteria- Content should include:

→Background
→Spiritual message
→Use this message in the day to day life
→Critical Analysis
→750 -1000 words

QUIZ COMPETITION GUIDELINES 2022

Quiz competition is aimed at improving Sunday school children's knowledge on biblical, church history, faith and tradition aspects. In 2022, we aim to conduct quiz competitions at Unit level, District **level and Diocese level** based on the guidelines given below with a view to promote children's general knowledge anchored on Sunday school education. The competition will be held via Kahoot, to which the guidelines are provided.

Individual Guidelines

- 1. For talent Event 2022, Intermediates and seniors are to participate in District Level Quiz Competition which will be held on 10th Sept 2022 at the same time across all the zones.
- 2. Quiz competition can be held for juniors, intermediate and seniors at UNIT level.
- 3. Head teachers should ensure to send the names of first and second prize winners of intermediate and senior age groups from Unit level competition to the respective district coordinators by 11th June 2022.
- 4. Quiz competition questions to be prepared at unit level based on the following topics:

INTERMEDIATES TOPICS

- Diptychs 25 %
- St John 25%
- Holy Baptism 25%
- Church history & Tradition (Restrict to Malankara history from Synod of Diamper till now) 25%

SENIORS TOPICS

- Revelation 25 %
- Holy Confession 25%
- Liturgy of Nineveh Lent 25%
- Church history & Tradition (Restrict to Malankara history from Synod of Diamper till now) 25%
- 5. Winners at unit level will be contesting at District level (10th September 2022) and thereafter District level winners will be contesting at the Diocese level (8th October 2022).
- The decision of the quizmaster will be final and will not be subjected to any change.
- The participants shall not be allowed to use any books, manuscripts, mobile phones or other electronic instruments.

RULES & GUIDELINES FOR TALENT EVENT 2022

<u>Unit Level</u>

Sunday school units should conduct talent competition **on a date which suits the unit's convenience**, but it should be conducted in consultation with vicar and teacher's council, and by ensuring the presence of Vicar or a Priest authorised by the vicar at the venue of the competition.

All the judges should not be from the respective parishes. Panel of three judges must at least include one from outside the parish. Competition should be conducted in the presence of parish Vicar who can be one of the judges. Under special circumstances of a parish/unit, judge/s may be selected from the same parish preferably among someone whose children are not directly involved in Sunday school activities of that parish. In such circumstances, Head teachers should notify their District Coordinators of the same. Under such circumstances, one member of the panel of judges should be one of our Priests. The Vicar, who is the chairman/president of the Sunday school unit, will be the final authority with regards the unit level competition judgement and announcement of the winners on the same day of competition.

Head Teachers should notify the details of competition after the competition to their respective District coordinators within the deadline

SUMMARY

- 1. The unit level event should be conducted impartially and organizers must adhere to the guidelines given in this Circular for the particular events.
- 2. Unit level event should be organized and supervised by the Head Teacher <u>only</u> in consultation with teacher's council headed by the parish Vicar. In case of any inconvenience <u>only</u> his/her deputy or a senior teacher of the respective Sunday school should be authorized to conduct the event. Head teachers should give enough notice to the candidates, for them to prepare well in advance.
- 3. Head teachers to ensure winners list for Solo song and Elocution are send to the respective District coordinators by 11th June 2022.
- 4. Send the list of the first and second prize winners of Quiz Competition for intermediate and senior levels to the District coordinators by 11th June 2022.
- 5. All participants will be receiving unit level certificates for their performances. All participants will be granted points on internal assessment.
- 6. Only regular students are eligible to participate in talent event. Those students who do not have regular attendance, discontinued or disqualified students and private students (matured students who do not fall in the age category) are not eligible to participate in any levels of talent competitions.
- 7. All communications from OSSAE-UK, Europe & Africa Office will be made to the head teacher only.

- 8. The rules for the event and topics for the elocution will be as per this circular. It will be the participant's responsibility to learn to manage time.
- 9. Sunday school units may continue to organize suitable Co-Curricular activities which include arts & sports and other events, such as Bible quiz, Bible reading, story writing, drawing and coloring for promoting various talents of our students.
- 10. The decision of the judges would be final at all level of competitions and any complaints arising from the competition should be directed to the head teacher of the respective Sunday school.

APPENDIX I: APPEAL PROCEDURE

The Appeal Committee consists of the following people:

- a. The Vice President
- b. Director
- c. Secretary
- d. Talent Competition Coordinator and
- e. Talent Competition Assistant Coordinator (if required)

General guidelines

- 1. In case of any concern regarding the Talent Event, the participant or their parents could raise an appeal in a written format duly signed. This should be forwarded by the respective Head Teacher's **only** after the approval by their parish Vicar.
- 2. The written appeal should be scanned and emailed to the OSSAE-UK Director and Secretary within 5 days after the event. Appeals after this time period will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 3. A decision will be made on the appeals within two weeks and the same will be communicated by the Director to the concerned Head Teacher.


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APPENDIX II: KAHOOT GUIDELINE

When you are ready to conduct the quiz with students, click Play button.





You can use the Play in preview mode to test the quiz yourself:




Now you can share the screen with your class and students need to join from their mobile or computer. Students can either download Kahoot mobile app or just go to browser and type www.kahoot.it. They will then see the following screen



Students now need to enter the Game pin, which will be uniquely generated for each game, above example it is 8950124. This number will be different every time you play the game. Students will then see the following screen where they enter their name,

Then they will see the following screen


Now they are ready to play.

As each student join, you will see their name on your screen:




Once all the students are ready and you can see all their names, click the start button on the top right.


You will then be taken to the first question first, and then it will show the answer options as well:




Students will see only answer options on their screen:




Students will then see their result; "Correct" response with the points they earned for this question or "Incorrect" message as.
